pregnancy diagnosis and infertilityrelated problems.

As part of the intervention, one cow and one buffalo in heat were artificially inseminated using improved variety semen straws of Sahiwal and Murrah breeds, respectively, to enhance genetic potential and productivity of local livestock.

In addition, all animals brought to the camp were dewormed and provided mineral mixtures to improve their overall health and nutritional status.

The camp received a positive response from livestock farmers and proved beneficial in creating awareness about scientific animal management practices.
