In an effort to promote experiential learning and awareness about modern agriculture, a group of students from Government Senior Secondary School (GSSS), Bakultala, visited ICAR-Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), North & Middle Andaman, on 30th October 2025. The educational excursion aimed to provide students with practical exposure to agricultural practices and innovations.

The visit began with a welcome address by Mr. Rakesh Dawar, Subject Matter Specialist (Agronomy), who introduced the students to the various activities and facilities of the KVK. The students explored crop demonstration fields, fisheries units, farm mechanization setups, integrated farming systems, and vermicomposting units. They also learned about climate-resilient technologies, sustainable farming methods, and the importance of agriculture in ensuring food and nutritional security.
